Christmas may have been fixed in proximity to pre-existing pagan feasts to cement the Christian ascendance over paganism. The time of these existing feasts, notably the Roman Saturnalia, were themselves based upon the Winter Solstice.


In the past, Christmas was a season more than a day as in the song, "the Twelve Days of Christmas.
